- 1. Have you and your masjid acknowledged Domestic Violence in Muslim communities during the National FIRST FRIDAY FOR FAMILIES on October 6th by wearing your purple hijabs, overgarments, and ribbons to give voice to the voiceless. Khutbas and educational materials related to positive Islamic models of marriage are encouraged. - Our Muslim Brothers can take a moment to endorse the Peaceful Partner 2. Pledge on the PFP website telling the world that to be the head of your household you do not need to be oppressive or violent.
- Sponsor a fundraiser for PFP or a local Domestic Violence service in your 3. own community to remind the world that Islam protects all people, especially believing women and children.
